Palabras Opuestas

Content: 26 cards

Description: This set of 13 pictures and their corresponding names is designed to help the students learn opposite words in Spanish. The cards are large enough to be used in large groups of students.

How to use the cards: a) As tools to introduce new vocabulary. b) As flash cards. c) *Memory game* or *Juego de Memoria*: Place a given number of pairs face down (picture card with corresponding name card). During his/her turn, the student turns two cards; if they match (i.e., two opposite words) the student keeps them; if not, the cards are placed back face down and it is the next student's turn. The student who has the most number of pairs wins. d) *Flyswatter* or *Matamoscas*: Tape the picture cards to a wall. The students are divided into two teams forming two lines. Give a flyswatter to the first student on each team. Name in English one of the cards and the student who *swats* the correct card first wins a point for his/her team.
